Open to current AL ARNG AGR Enlisted Soldiers only.

Duty Position Job Description/Criteria:

Conducts recruiting activities on assigned college campus for both the Alabama Army National Guard and for Army ROTC. Serves as instructor for Military Science I & II courses, conducts physical training with ROTC Cadets, assists with Cadet Lab Training and participates in other ROTC training events to include Field Training Exercises. ROTC support is limited to 20 hours per week. The remainder of the duty week will be dedicated to recruiting activities on the assigned campus. Individual selected must be able to pass APFT, meet AR 600-9 standards, possess dynamic interpersonal skills, and project a very high level of military appearance and discipline.

Recruiter Qualification Requirements:

Must meet medical standards IAW AR 40-501, chapter 3 or 4. A physical profile of 132221.

Must have a 110 GT score, an E-5 and above who does not have a minimum score of 110 in GT can receive a waiver with a 100 GT and 96 or above in ST on ASVAB.

High school diploma graduates or has completed one (1) year of college with a GED (no waiver).

Individual selected must meet selection criteria in National Guard Regulations 601-1, 600-200, 600-5, 600-10, 601-280, and AR 135-18 as applicable.

No record of conviction by special or general courts-martial or civilian courts of offenses listed in AR 27-10 (military justice), chapter 24, or otherwise required to register as a sexual offender under AR 27-10, chapter 24.

Individual selected must complete SQI-4 course within 12 months and be prepared to complete Cadet Command Instructor Course as required.

This position will incur a maximum tour length of 48 months, upon completion the selected SM will return to traditional FTUS assignment.
