2. Interested Soldiers that are **(ONE)** grade below the authorized rank are encouraged to apply. Soldiers do not have to be MOS qualified to apply. They must be able to be awarded the MOS in accordance with DA PAM 611-21. Soldiers must be a graduate of Advanced Leaders Course (ALC). A Staff Sergeant waiver may be granted to a Sergeant promotable ALC graduate by the Commandant, US Army Signal School. Soldiers cannot be under any suspension of favorable actions for any reason, and must have passed both an APFT and Height/Weight standards within 18 months of the suspense (closing date). Soldiers without a current PHA will be considered for the position but will not be promoted until completion of an approved PHA.
