Open Statewide to all AGR, Military Technician and Traditional Guardsman in grades E5 through E6 who are current members of the Alabama Army National Guard.

SM must be or be able to become 35F MOSQ within 12 months of accepting the position. Applicant must have or be able to attain a Top Secret Security Clearance.

#### **Duty Position Job Description/Criteria:**

The principal advisor on information security in the command and is responsible to the commander for management of the program. Will have direct access to the commander on matters affecting the information security program. Will Advise and represent the commander on matters related to the classification, downgrading, declassification, and safeguarding of national security information. Establish and implement an effective security education program for the command. Establish procedures for ensuring that DA personnel who handle classified material are properly cleared in accordance with AR 380. Advise and assist officials on classification problems and the development of classification guidance. Ensure that classification guides for classified plans, programs, projects, or mission are properly prepared, approved, distributed, and maintained. Conduct a periodic review of classifications assigned within the activity, to ensure classification decisions are consistent with DoD classification guidelines, operational and statutory requirements. Review classified and CUI documents in coordination with the command records management officer. Continually reduce, by declassification, destruction, decontrol, or retirement, as appropriate, unneeded classified information and CUI. Oversee or conduct security inspections and spot checks for compliance with this regulation and other security regulations and directives and notify the commander of the results. Assist and advise the commander in matters pertaining to the enforcement of regulations governing the access to, and the dissemination, reproduction, transmission, transportation, safeguarding, and destruction of classified information or CUI and material. Make recommendations, based on applicable regulations and directives, on requests for visits by foreign nationals and foreign government representatives. Provide security and disclosure guidance if the visit request is approved. Ensure violations of this regulation, including suspected compromises or other threats to the safeguarding of classified information and the unauthorized disclosure of CUI, are reported and investigated in accordance with this regulation. Establish and maintain visitor control procedures in cases in which visitors are authorized access to classified information or to areas where classified material is stored and or processed. Issue contingency plans for the emergency destruction of classified information, when necessary, and for the safeguarding of classified information used in or near hostile or potentially hostile areas. Be the single point of contact to coordinate and resolve classification or declassification problems. Report data as required by this regulation.

#### IAW DA PAM 611-21 qualifications for initial award of the applicable MOS:

(1) A physical demands rating of moderate (Gold).

- (2) A physical profile of 222221.
- (3) Normal color vision.
- (4) Qualifying scores.

(a) A minimum score of 101 in aptitude area ST.

(b) A minimum OPAT score of Long Jump (LJ) - 120 cm, seated Power Throw (PT) - 350 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) - 120 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) - 36 shuttles in Physical Demand Category "Moderate" (Gold).

(5) Never been a member of the U.S. Peace Corps, except as specified in AR 614-200 (para 3-2.d). (6) U.S. citizen.

(7) Security Eligibility(a) An Interim Top Secret Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS//SCI) clearance required for initial MOS award.(b) To maintain the MOS, a fully adjudicated TS//SCI must be obtained within 12 months of initial MOS award. (c) For clearance requirements to attend training, refer to the Army Training Requirements and Resources System (ATRRS)

## QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a Federally recognized member of the Army National Guard of Alabama.

2. Must be able to serve at least 3 years in an active military status prior to: (a) Completing 18- years of active Federal service, or (b) The date of mandatory removal (without any extension under any provision of law or regulation from Ready Reserve status based on age or service as prescribed by current directives).

3. Meet medical standards as prescribed by AR 40-501, chapter 3, 4 or 5.

- 4. Must meet physical standards prescribed by AR 600-9.
- 5. Must not be under current suspension of favorable personnel actions.

6. Applicants who voluntarily separate from the AGR program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from date of separation.

7. Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal military retired or retainer pay, receive Federal civil service annuities, or be eligible for immediate Federal civil service annuities.

8. Individuals who voluntarily resign from the AGR program in lieu of adverse personnel actions are not eligible to reenter the program.

9. Individuals who have been separated from other military services for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service (other than temporary medical disability) are ineligible to enter the AGR program.

10. Individuals who would attain 18 or more years of active military service during their initial tour period of AGR duty are ineligible to enter the AGR program.

11. Individuals involuntarily separated from the AGR program are not eligible to reenter the program.

12. Eligibility of females will be consistent with existing Department of the Army Combat Exclusion policies. Selection and nomination will be made from those applicants' determined best qualified in terms principally involving experience, demonstrated ability, performance, training and education.

13. Must be eligible for AGR service IAW AR 135-18.

14. Must be Airborne qualified or able to pass an Airborne Physical and become Airborne qualified within 12 months from selection of the position.

15. Must be able to obtain and maintain a top secret clearance. Security clearance must not be suspended or denied.

# In accordance with AR 135-18, Staff Sergeant or above must possess the required grade and MOS level authorized for the AGR duty position. Sergeants or below must have the potential to become MOS qualified in the first 12 months or be released for active duty/FTN
