Duty Position Job Description/Criteria:

Serves as a Supply NCO. Selected individual will be responsible for overseeing, evaluating, and processing all Logistics-related matters for Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics (DCSLOG). As a Supply NCO, individual performs and supervise duties involving CSDPs, SAVs, Excess equipment, and Delinquent DST directives. Performs operator duties on assigned computer systems and equipment (GCSS-Army, ISM, DTS, AESIP, FMS web, etc.). Provides technical guidance to MACOM/BN PBOs and Unit Supply Personnel. Evaluate all unit/organizational supply documents. Ensure automated supply system for accounting of organizational and installation supplies and equipment is maintained IAW applicable Army regulations. Ensure small arms are issued and received IAW established procedures. Evaluates the physical security measures of weapons, ammunition, and other sensitive items of AL ARNG units. Evaluates sensitive items inventories on inspected units to ensure 100% accountability. Coordinates supply activities. **This position requires extensive TDY, about 75% of the year. The position is on the DCSLOG Command Supply Discipline Program (CSDP) Team who conducts CSDPs all MACOMs/BDEs and DRUs to JFHQ in the state. This will also include any follow-ups to CSDPs and Staff Assistance Visits (SAV). All E6's must be MOS qualified. The duty hours for this position are IAW full-time duty status including nights and weekends. Due to the nature and mission of the organization, work hours are subject to change without notice.**
