Duty Position Job Description/Criteria:

As the Unit Supply Sergeant, the individual supervises or performs duties involving maintenance, requests, receipt, storage, issue, accountability, and preservation of individual, organizational, installation and expendable supplies and equipment. The selected individual will have an understanding of receiving, inspecting, inventorying, loading, unloading, segregating, storing, issuing, delivering and returning organization and installation supplies and equipment. Prepare all unit/organizational supply documents. Responsible for ordering and scheduling meals and lodging. Maintain automated supply system for accounting of organizational and installation supplies and equipment. The selected individual may or may not perform the following duties but should have and/or develop a detailed understanding: Issue and receive small arms. Secure and control weapons and ammunition in security areas. Schedule and perform preventive and organizational maintenance on weapons. Coordinate supply activities. Review and annotate changes to unit material condition status report. Coordinate with battalion personnel to ensure that equipment and supplies are available and ready for events and other training activities as scheduled. Perform operator duties and unit level maintenance functions on assigned computer systems and equipment (GCSS-Army, ISM, DTS, RCAS, etc.). Additional duties as assigned.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Must meet the physical qualifications outlined in AR 40-501, as appropriate. Must comply with the military duty eligibility requirements IAW DA Pam 611-21.
2. Must not be flagged for weight, AFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions.
