DUTY STATUS: This is a Temporary Active-Duty (Title 10 MPA Days) opportunity for Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve officers.

Position Description:

The member serves as an Instructor Support Officer within AFROTC Detachment 005 at Auburn University. This position provides temporary active-duty support under Military Personnel Appropriation (MPA) funding to assist the detachment staff in executing cadet training, leadership development, and administrative operations. The officer acts as an advisor and mentor to cadets and a liaison between the Det and local Air National Guard and Reserve units.

- Support administrative functions such as cadet records, event coordination, and logistics.
- Provide mentorship and professional development guidance to cadets.
- Coordinate with Detachment staff to plan and execute training events and community outreach.
- Serve as a subject-matter expert for Air Force culture, leadership, and mentorship topics.

Workload and Funding:

- Full-time from 2 March to 29 May 2026.
- Orders funded by AFROTC MPA Days (88 days in FY26).
- No travel or per diem funding available – member must be local to the Auburn area.

Training Requirements:

- 81T AFSC qualified or eligible (preferably current or prior AFROTC or OTS instructor experience).
- Current fitness test and medical readiness in accordance with AFMAN 36-2100 and DAFMAN 48-123.

Other:

Applicants must be members in good standing of the Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve and eligible for Title 10 MPA orders. Members will remain administratively assigned to their home unit for pay and personnel actions.

Mandatory Documents:

1. Detailed resume or military biography.
