AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open Statewide to all AGR, Military Technician and Traditional Guardsman in grades E4 through E6 who are current members of the Alabama Army National Guard.

SM must be 68W MOS Qualified. Applicant must have or be able to attain a secret security clearance.

Duty Position Job Description/Criteria:

This position is located at the Medical Aid Facility at Fort McClellan. The purpose of this position is to work in concert with the Ft McClellan Command Staff as the medical coordinator ensuring proper medical coverage and oversight attending all meetings as required; assist in the daily operations of the Medical Aid Facility. Provide continuity between the MEDDET, State Surgeon's Office, and Fort McClellan ensuring all medical requirements are tracked and communicated. As a health care NCO you will provide emergency medical treatment, limited primary care, force health protection, evacuation in a variety of operational and clinical settings from point of injury or illness through the continuum of military health care and, as a field combat medic, provides emergency medical care/treatment at point of wounding on the battlefield or to battle and non-battle casualties during wartime. Administer emergency medical treatment to battlefield casualties, assists with outpatient care and treatment or assists with inpatient care and treatment under the supervision of a physician, nurse, physician's assistant or a health care NCO. Supervise activities of field, clinical and mobile treatment facilities. Provides Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) Services support to units on a regional basis. Services include: Routine Adult Immunizations, HIV Testing, Pregnancy Testing, Dental Exams, PHA's, Vision Screenings, Over 40 Screenings, Detailed Case Management Support, MODS User training/Data update, 68W Sustainment training/tracking, BLS and CLS Support. Perform administrative and supply duties as required, and additional duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a federally recognized member of the Army National Guard of Alabama.
2. Must be able to serve at least 3 years in an active military status prior to: (a) Completing 18-years of active Federal service, or (b) The date of mandatory removal (without any extension under any provision of law or regulation from Ready Reserve status based on age or service as prescribed by current directives).
3. Meet medical standards as prescribed by AR 40-501, chapter 3, 4 or 5.
4. Must meet physical standards prescribed by AR 600-9.
5. Must not be under current suspension of favorable personnel actions.
6. Applicants who voluntarily separate from the AGR program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from date of separation. Applicants must not be entitled to receive

Federal military retired or retainer pay, receive Federal civil service annuities, or be eligible for immediate Federal civil service annuities.

7. Individuals who voluntarily resign from the AGR program in lieu of adverse personnel actions are not eligible to reenter the program.

8. Individuals who have been separated from other military services for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service (other than temporary medical disability) are ineligible to enter the AGR program.

9. Individuals who would attain 18 or more years of active military service during their initial tour period of AGR duty are ineligible to enter the AGR program.

10. Individuals involuntarily separated from the AGR program are not eligible to reenter the program.

11. Must be eligible for AGR service IAW AR 135-18.

12. Must be able to obtain and maintain a secret clearance. Security clearance must not be suspended or denied.

13. Must be MOS Qualified

14. No documented instances in the last 5 years of conduct which reflects adversely on the character, honesty, or integrity of the Soldier to include:

(a) No conviction by court-martial or by any Federal or state court.

(b) No punishment under Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) or Alabama Code of Military Justice (ACMJ) caused by incidents that reflect adversely on the Soldiers integrity and lack of trust.

(c) No letter of reprimand, censure, or admonition under the provisions of AR 600-37

15. All permanently filed adverse documents from any time or service in any component must be disclosed and included with packet. Soldier can provide additional explanation as needed.

Failure to disclose all documents above may result in curtailment of the AGR Tour.

Special Requirements:

a. Must have exceptional oral communication and writing skills.

b. Individuals must attend all periods of IDT/AT

Additional Requirements:

1. Must meet the physical qualifications outlined in AR 40-501, as appropriate. Must comply with the military duty eligibility requirements IAW DA Pam 611-21.

2. Must not be flagged for weight, ACFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions.

3. This position requires some travel and training away from home station.

4. Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of their education, experience, training and performance. Consideration will be based on available information contained in the individual's application and personal interview.
