POSITION TITLE: Area Support Group Black Sea (ASG-BS) Senior Enlisted Advisor

SELECTING OFFICIAL: ALNG Command Senior Enlisted Leader

REMARKS: A valid Government Travel Credit Card in good standing and with a current DTS profile is required.

LENGTH OF TOUR: Initial tour is 190 days and then renewed annually on 1 June for 365 days, subject to the 1825 rule. Tour is an unaccompanied PCS with ASG at the "without dependent rate" and without POV or HHG shipment authorized.

PROJECTED TOUR START DATE: May 24, 2025

WHO MAY APPLY: Currently serving Alabama National Guard Command Sergeants Major & Sergeants Major

BENEFITS: Selection and service as the ASG-BS Command Sergeant Major is considered as an O6 Brigade Command equivalency, and is considered a highly coveted broadening assignment, when applying for future E9 Brigade or Nominative positions (ALNG and Bench). Salary is by military grade and time in service. Member is authorized Subsistence allowance, government supplied quarters, annual leave, medical and dental care. Military Exchange and Commissary privilege.

DUTY POSITION REQUIREMENTS AND JOB DESCRIPTION/CRITERIA:

To serve as the Command Sergeant Major (Senior Enlisted Advisor) to the Commander (O6 – Brigade Equivalent/Non-Nominative) of the ASG Black Sea; directly supporting the regional host nations of Romania, Bulgaria, and Greece.

ASG-BS serves as a high value and strategic theater level security cooperation line of effort. ASG-BS presence ensures that the United States Army European Theater assets, and coalition partners are ready, lethal combat-credible, and are strategically positioned across the European Theater to deter aggression and reassure our allies and partners of the U.S. commitment to peace and stability in Europe.

ASG-BS serves as a subordinate to the 21st Theater Sustainment Command ensuring superior logistics support across the AOR. The Command Sergeant Major serves as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the ASG BS Commander supporting U.S. Forces in the AOR for rotational and Joint/Multinational/bilateral exercises for the duration of the mobilization period along with other requirements, as necessary. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION FOR TITLE 10 TOURS:

1. Must be federally recognized member of the Alabama National Guard
2. Meet medical standards as prescribed by DoD Regulations
3. Must meet physical standards prescribed by DoD regulations.
4. Must have current Secret or higher clearance.
5. Must not be under current suspension of favorable personnel actions
6. Selection and nomination is made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, gender, political affiliation, or age.
