Mission Description: Option for 1 year tour upon availability of FY25 funding. The Deputy HNA RO supports the HNA RO in representing the Commanding General, USAREUR-AF to the United States Ambassador to Romania and to the appropriate Romanian officials at national, county and local level and performs the duties of the HNA RO in the absence of the incumbent. The Deputy HNA RO will:

(1) Enhance the capability and readiness of U.S. Forces and their Romanian regional partners to respond faster to aggression in Europe and transnational threats by developing cooperative working relationships with key Romanian officials at all levels of government, and through these relationships, enable rapid and effective responses to support U.S. Forces training and operational requirements.

(2) Develop a comprehensive understanding of Romanian political systems, civic organizations, and other institutions to identify specific areas in which cooperation with the host nation could bolster their security and capacity. Recommend to USAREUR-AF programs to strengthen national resiliency and reinforce Romanian willingness to support NATO burden sharing.

(3) Build effective working relationships with Romanian officials at all levels to support and improve theater Joint Reception, Staging, Onward Movement, and Integration (JRSOI). Exercise and improve the effectiveness of these relationships through cooperation and coordination in exercises such as DEFENDER 21 and other similar exercises.

(4) Perform other duties as assigned in support of the HNA RO mission, including participation in U.S. Embassy Bucharest country team meetings, representational events, and other engagements to foster and enhance the U.S. – Romanian relationship.
